During our time at Calvary we were able to serve the Lord in many wonderful ways and make some great and lasting friends. We will really miss the church and our kids at the school.

God has been leading me, for sometime now, to go back to my roots in evangelism. In 1971, Tim Goble and I, started the Jesus Way Evangelistic Association. Our focus, at that time, was Revivals, Crusades, Youth Rallies, Youth Camps, and mostly local Evangelistic Outreach. In 1974, the Lord called me into a local church, fulltime ministry. Now, it seems, I will be involved in Evangelism again with a focus on International Ministry.

I am now working through HELPING HAND INTERNATIONAL in an effort to not only open the door to preach and minister world wide, but to assist the sick and needy and helpless of the world.

FIRST INTERNATIONAL TRIP

God has opened the door for many great opportunities in 2006. As a matter of fact, they begin on January 11, 2006, with my trip to Kenya and Uganda, with an organization known as He Intends Victory, led by Rev. Bruce Sonnenberg. This organization focuses on people who have been affected by AIDS and have major health problems. This also includes many children who were born with HIV. All of these dear people need help and the Lord. This trip will last from January 11 to January 27. We will be preaching and ministering in such places as Nairobi, Entebbe, Jinja, Eldoret, Lake Victoria and many places in between. This is not only an Evangelistic Mission Trip but an errand of mercy as well.

HERE IS HOW YOU CAN HELP:

1. Over the years I have been blessed by people who have prayed for my family and I faithfully. Please place me on your prayer list and remember me, as well as my family, to the Lord each time you pray. The trip to Kenya and Uganda will be sixteen days of difficult travel and hardship.
2. For this trip I need \$3,238.00 for travel and expenses in Africa. I will also need \$2,100.00 for additional expenses here at home, for a total of \$5,338.00. This seems like such a large amount, however, I am trusting the Lord to provide. (Note: every contribution to HELPING HAND INTERNATIONAL is tax deductible)

FUTURE TRIPS IN 2006:

My trip to Kenya and Uganda is only the first of many in 2006. In February, I will be going to Mexico to join Pastor Roy Lofts in his work at Iglesia Bahia Concepcion. Later, in the year, I will be going to Korea, Brazil, Guatemala and the Philippines.

I am also making myself available for Bible Conferences, Revivals and Crusades wherever the Lord will open the door.

God has made it very clear in His word, in many places, that we are to reach out to the lost of the world. "...Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation" Mark 16:15.
